The Lumière brothers were French manufacturers of photography equipment, best known for their Cinématographe motion picture system and the short films they produced between 1895 and 1905, which places them among the earliest filmmakers.





ANNOUNCEMENT FROM HOME CARE & GOODWIN LIVING AT HOME

Understanding Home Care terminology becomes increasingly important to allow you to participate actively in your own care decisions.

- Activities of Daily Living (ADLs): The skills required to independently care for oneself include bathing, dressing, toileting, transferring, eating, and continence.
- Assessment: Done by a nurse to identify specific needs, preferences, and goals for care.
- Care Plan: Outlines the services/support you will receive.
- Home Care: Personal care services (assistance with ADLs) provided by an aide in your home.
- Long-Term Care Insurance: Insurance designed to help cover the costs of home care services for seniors that aren't covered by regular health insurance.


